

COLOUR CODED AWARDS EAST MIDLANDS

Certificates are available for competitors who meet the required standard for the same colour course. Courses are graded as follows:

WHITE - YELLOW – ORANGE – RED- LIGHT GREEN – GREEN – BLUE – BROWN

Standards are as follows:

White – by anyone who successfully completes three **WHITE** courses

All other courses are calculated using whichever of the following methods gives the larger number of qualifiers:

A. The time that is achieved by at least 50% of those who started the course, which includes those who retire or are disqualified. Each pair or group on the **YELLOW** and **ORANGE** courses (if any) should be treated as a single starter.

or

B. 150% of the winner's time,

In the East Midlands Men's and Women's times are calculated separately.
