Code of Conduct for Officials and Volunteers

Effective from 13 August 2009

All volunteers must -

- Consider the well-being and safety of participants before and after competition and the development of performance.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with participants, based on mutual trust and respect.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part.
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play and sportsmanship).
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour.
- Follow all guidelines laid down by the National Governing Body and the Club.
- Hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance cover.
- Never exert undue influence over participants to obtain personal benefit or reward.
- Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibited substances.
